ACL Disability Services and Gig Buddies Sydney requires all gig buddies and visitors to treat each other equally.



Please treat people with dignity and respect.



Everyone should be free from abuse and harassment



Gig Buddies Sydney (GBS) follows general Human Rights rules and NSW standards.

Discrimination and Harassment (Bullying)

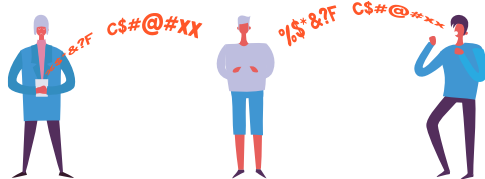
Discrimination means treating someone worse than other people for some reason.

Harassment (or bullying) is hurting or doing bad things to someone.
Harassment is being nasty, hitting, calling names or upsetting someone on purpose.
It can also be doing something that annoys or irritates another person on purpose.



GBS will not tolerate any discrimination or harassment (bullying) based on:

Disability
Race or Culture
Sexual preference
Gender
Age
Religion
or
other characteristics



Any negative, mean or aggressive comments or personal attacks (face-to-face or in writing) will be deemed verbal abuse.



Raised voices or speaking in an aggressive or rude manner will also be deemed verbal abuse.



Harassment can also be contacting someone more than they are comfortable with.

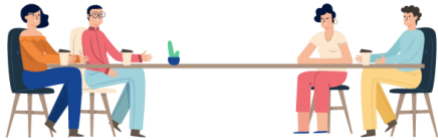
What happens if somebody goes against this policy?



When somebody reports to GBS about abuse that has happened, staff will look into it as soon as possible.



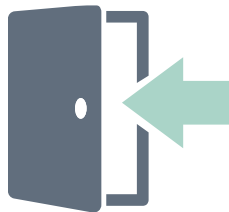
If the abuse is a criminal offence, staff will tell the police and the Gig Buddies CEO.



GBS staff may also arrange a meeting with all people involved.
GBS staff will take steps to sort out the problem.



If a solution cannot be reached, the people involved may not be able to stay in the Gig Buddies project.



If a person is warned about their behaviour but keeps on being offensive, they will be asked to leave the project, and other people may be asked to help (police or other).
