	<p>Jon told us that if someone harasses, threatens or intimidates you, you should call 000. The NSW Police take this very seriously and they respond to this urgently.</p>

	<p>Jon said that on the train that there is a panic button. If you feel unsafe, you can press this button and train guards and police will know where you are.</p>

	<p>Jon said that on the buses, try to put some distance between yourself and the harasser. You can also let the bus driver know what is happening and you can get them to call the police or stop the bus.</p>

We talked about cyber bullying with Jon. He said that if you are cyber bullied, print off screenshots of the bullying. (messages, pictures)- once it is printed off, take it to the local police station.



Jon said to us that being denied entry to a venue because of a disability is against the law. If this happens, report it to the manager of the place first and they will talk to their bouncers.



If you do report a crime, Jon said that you have the right to be treated fairly. If you feel like a police officer is not treating you with respect or taking you seriously, you can speak to the team sergeant.
